General Truck Rules

- 1 Must have Receiver Style Hitch fixed in all directions, not to exceed 26 inches to the top of hook point, with a minimum 3 inch inside diameter. 2WD modified class allows 28 inches.
- 2 Only one driver is considered for Award Placing (Points, Trophy, Money, etc.).
- 3 No passengers.
- 4 D.O.T. approved tires only.
- 5 No loose weights all weights MUST be secured, no hanging weights or weights exceeding the bumpers in stock classes.
- 6 Sled chain may be lengthened or raised for a pull off by track officials.
- 7 At the end of pull, back out of throttle so sled does not ram rear of truck.
- 8 All trucks must cross the scales immediately before they pull.
- 9 Failure to follow flag man's instructions (stop for red flag) will result in a disqualification.
- 10 Age Restrictions: Drivers must be at least 16 years of age with parental consent.
- 11 Diesel trucks pull the Diesel Class only.
- 12 All trucks must be safe to pull at the track official's discretion.
- 13 At least 3 trucks are required to make a class.
- 14 No NOS or propane permitted in any class.
- 15 All diesels with open (after-market) exhaust must have safety crosses installed after the turbo.
- 16 4X4 may disengage and pull in 2WD.
- 17 All Modified and outlaw trucks must follow NTPA Drive line safety rules
- 18 Must wear DOT approved helmet at all times when hooked to the sled.

Gas Classes – Trucks Rules

2-WD Street Stock

- 1 Limited to 6,200 Lbs
- 2 D.O.T. approved tires
- 3 One ton or less factory type drive train with factory suspension in place.
- 4 All other General/Safety Rules apply

2-WD Modified

- 1 Limited to 5,200 Lbs
- 2 D.O.T. approved tires or under 35 inches
- 3 Naturally aspirated only (no NOS)
- 4 A fire extinguisher in the cab or accessible to the driver.
- 5 Kill switch
- 6 All other General/Safety Rules apply
- 7 Hitch not to exceed 28 inches

4X4 Street

1 Limited to 6,400 Lbs

- 2 D.O.T. approved tires
- 3 One ton or less factory type drive train with factory suspension in place.
- 4 All other General/Safety Rules apply

4X4 Modified

- 1 Limited to 6,200 Lbs
- 2 D.O.T. approved tires or under 35 inches
- 3 Naturally aspirated only (no NOS)
- 4 Hanging weights may not extend more than 60" from centerline of front axle.
- 5 Hitch must be a minimum of 36" from centerline of rear axle.
- 6 All other General/Safety Rules apply

Diesel Truck Classes Rules Work Diesel

- 1 Limited to 8,000 Lbs
- 2 No hanging Weights
- 3 Stock motor and drive train, stock turbo
- 4 Aftermarket computers/programmers, exhaust and air intake permitted
- 5 This class is for the everyday driver and new comers
- 6 Any truck dominating the class will be moved to SD for the new season

<u>Street Diesel</u>

- 1 Limited to 8,000 Lbs
- 2 Must run DOT tires.
- 3 Hanging weights may not extend more than 60 inches from the centerline of front axle.
- 4 Aftermarket Turbo (2.6 or smaller)
- 5 Blocked rear ends permitted
- 6 Aftermarket computers/programmers, exhaust and air intake permitted

Outlaw Diesel

- 1 Limited to 8,000 Lbs
- 2 Can run pulling tires.
- 3 Hanging weights may not extend more than 60 inches from the centerline of front axle.
- 4 Aftermarket Turbo (larger than 2.6)
- 5 Blocked rear ends permitted
- 6 Aftermarket computers/programmers, exhaust and air intake permitted
- 7 All Trucks with performance modifications not permitted in WD or SD Classes, not exceeding 8,000 lbs

<u>Heavy Diesel</u>

- 1 Any Diesel truck that exceeds 8,000 Lbs
- All standard rules Hitch, safety, and overall conduct apply
